Pen and wash describes the medium whereby watercolour techniques are combined with a drawn ink line. It may be precise or very freely handled: it is therefore a very versatile medium and exciting to explore.

*Morning session:* Exploring the long history of the medium: its techniques, pens, nibs, ink and paper.  
*Afternoon session:* Supervised work with encouragement for each student to develop their style.  
*Requirements :* HB pencil, eraser, black waterproof Indian Ink, a "school " style type pen holder and nib.  
Good quality drawing or watercolour paper, a rag, tissues, watercolours if you have them.  
A note book and brushes. Bamboo and twig pens will be provided
